






Expansion of Innovation in Agri-Food Based on strategic initiatives - Examples

proposals – planned dates in 2020: Sept. 03rd 2020, Nov. 05th 2020

Call Closure: July 28th 2021, 17:00 (Brussels time)

or earlier, in case reserved budget is completely allocated

Implementation: latest until July 2022 – usually a project duration of 12-18 months
