

[LIVESTREAM-TV] Grammy Awards 2023 Live Show Free Online Broadcast 5th February 2023

2023 Grammy Awards Red Carpet kicks off the 65th annual event today starting on Sunday, February 5 at 3 p.m. PT / 6 p.m. ET at Crypto.com Arena in Los Angeles leading up to the main awards hosted by entertainer Trevor Noah.



Tonight, the 65th annual Grammy Awards—otherwise known as music’s biggest night—will kick off in L.A. at the Crypto.com Arena, airing live at 8 P.M EST. This year, Trevor Noah will host the event, which celebrates nominees including ABBA, Adele, Beyoncé, Bad Bunny, Harry Styles, and more. In addition to performances from artists like Styles and Bad Bunny, there will be a special set from Missy Elliott, Queen Latifah, Lil Wayne, Busta Rhymes, and more honoring the 50th anniversary of hip-hop.

Viola Davis, picking up her Grammy Award for spoken word album. Davis has an Emmy for “How to Get Away With Murder,” an Oscar for “Fences,” a Tony for both “King Hedley II” and “Fences” and now a Grammy for her audiobook performance of her memoir “Finding Me.”

US first lady Jill Biden will attend this year's Grammy Awards as a presenter, the White House said on Wednesday. The Grammys separately announced the lineup of those presenting at the award show, a list that includes rapper Cardi B, pop sensation Olivia Rodrigo, actor Dwayne Johnson, actress Viola Davis, "When Harry Met Sally" star Billy Crystal, comedian James Corden and Canadian pop artist Shania Twain.

The Grammys are also one of the four major American entertainment awards needed to achieve an EGOT.
